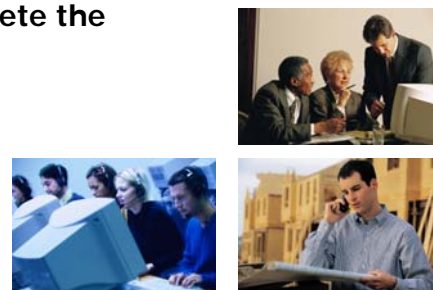
Eligibility:
